Monitor events in real time

When medication or a dosage is updated or changed in the Birdie Agency Hub, it's instantly visible to your care staff.

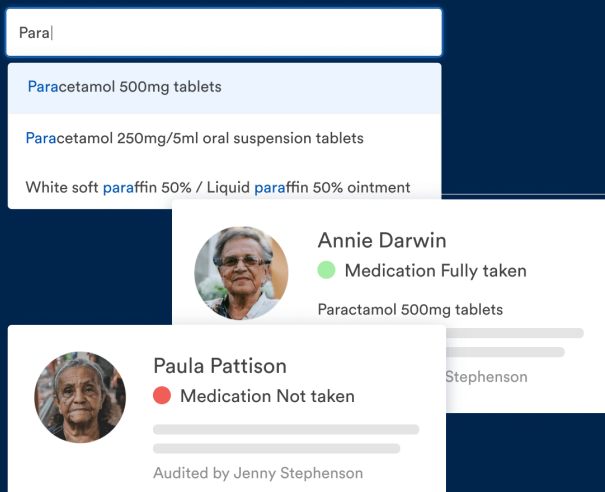

Pre-loaded NHS database medication list

Birdie is linked in realtime to the NHS database of 150,000 medications, meaning there's less chance of human error or entering an incorrect dosage into the MAR.

Real-time alerts

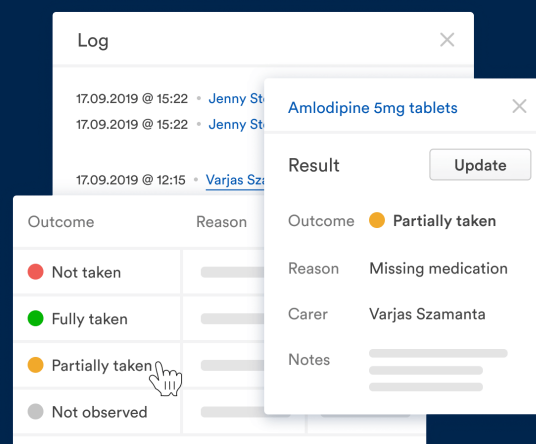
Get alerted in real-time of any medication issue raised by your staff and act on them instantly.
